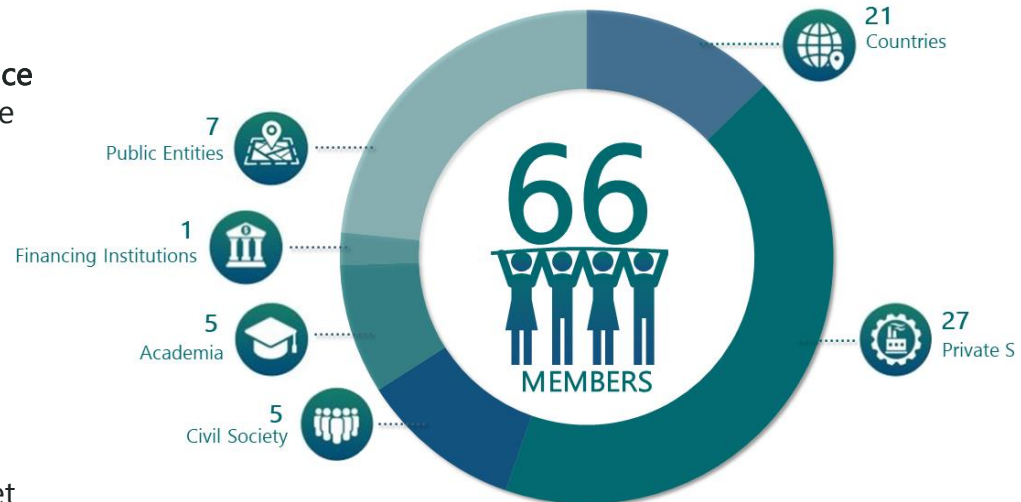
# 1. **COPA Introduction**

## COPA IS A GLOBAL ALLIANCE

### - *memberdriven activities to reduce ODS and HFC banks*

- COPA works jointly with partner **countries and members** across private and public sectors
- COPA advance holistic solutions needed to **reduce ODS and HFC banks**, and ultimately complete the shift in the cooling sector to sustainable refrigerant management.
- Currently **66 members** in total, of which **21 countries** (Feb 2023)
- **Membership is free of cost**
- Members are expected to **actively contribute** to COPA activities, e.g. in Working Groups and Meet & Greet Events, Thematic Workshops, Study Tours etc.



## COPA THEMATIC WORKING GROUPS (TWG)



### Policy Framework

Developing suitable policy measures for effective management of refrigerants and foams at their end-of-life stage.



### Technology Solutions

Working towards the best technical solutions for ODS and HFC recovery, reclamation and destruction



### Financing Mechanism

Developing financial mechanisms for sustainable GHG mitigation measures in ODS and HFC banks



### Implementation Models
